

KS3 RE Learning Journey

7.1 - Creation & Covenant

Students will understand the creation stories and look at the nature of God. Explore religious and scientific perspectives. Look at their roles as stewards of the Earth.

7.2 - Prophecy & Promise

Students explore the structure of the Bible and understand the importance of sacred scripture and sacred tradition. They will make links to how scripture is used in Mass and the Rosary.

7.3 - Galilee to Jerusalem

Students will understand how Jesus is seen as human and divine. They will explore the different titles given to Jesus. They will also know the importance of God the Son through the Trinity.

7.4 - Desert to Garden

Students will develop an understanding of the importance of the paschal mystery, Eucharist and different Christian beliefs, sacraments. Know the structure of Mass.

7.5 - The Ends of the Earth

Students will know and understand the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of Jesus and for Christians today. Know the story of Pentecost. The sacrament of confirmation.

7.6 - Dialogue & Encounter

Students will understand the importance of Church councils. Understand why there are different Christian denominations. Students will know and understand key aspects of Hinduism.

Year 7

8.5 - The Ends of the Earth

Students will have knowledge and understanding of the importance of the resurrection of Christ. They will explore whether or not humans have a soul, life after death and the importance of baptism and funeral rites.

8.3 - Galilee to Jerusalem

Students will know and understand what the Kingdom of God is and how Jesus helped the marginalised. Students will know the parables and miracles of Jesus. Students will learn about the anointing of the sick.

8.2 - Prophecy & Promise

Students will study and understand the different themes in prophecies. Explore the importance of John the Baptist and how as lay people we are witnesses of Christ. Be able to link prophecy to advent.

Year 8



8.1 - Creation & Covenant

Students will know the origins of original sin in Genesis, the role of commandments, conscience and the sacrament of baptism.

8.6 - Dialogue & Encounter

Students will know and understand the importance of second Vatican council and the importance of Ecclesiam Suam.. Students will know and understand key aspects of Islam.

8.4 - Desert to Garden

Students will understand what suffering and explore the sufferings of Jesus. Students will learn about Lent and sacrament of reconciliation.

Year 9

9.1 - Creation & Covenant

Students will study and identify moral issues with the key themes of the sanctity of life, creation of life and marriage.

9.3 - Galilee to Jerusalem

Students will study and understand the relationships between Jesus and his disciples, outcasts and women, this will lead to the Church's teaching on vocation and why only certain people can fulfil the role of priest.

9.6 - Dialogue & Encounter

Students will know, understand and analyse key aspects of Judaism.

Students will study and understand themes relating to Mary, her impact and how we can live like her today.

9.4 - Desert to Garden

Students will study and understand Catholic teaching on forgiveness and redemption with an emphasis on how this impacts Catholics today.

Students will study Catholic teaching on the authority of the Church, angels and the impact of these teachings for Catholics today.
