# Camaraderie (noun)

Mutual trust and friendship among people.

**Camaraderie** can be seen as a practical, lived expression of solidarity and peace.

It mirrors the principle of solidarity by reminding us that we are all responsible for one another; it shifts the focus from "me" to "us." When you practice **camaraderie** you are actively building a culture of peace. This is because true peace is not just the absence of an argument, but the presence of strong, trusting relationships where everyone feels valued.
