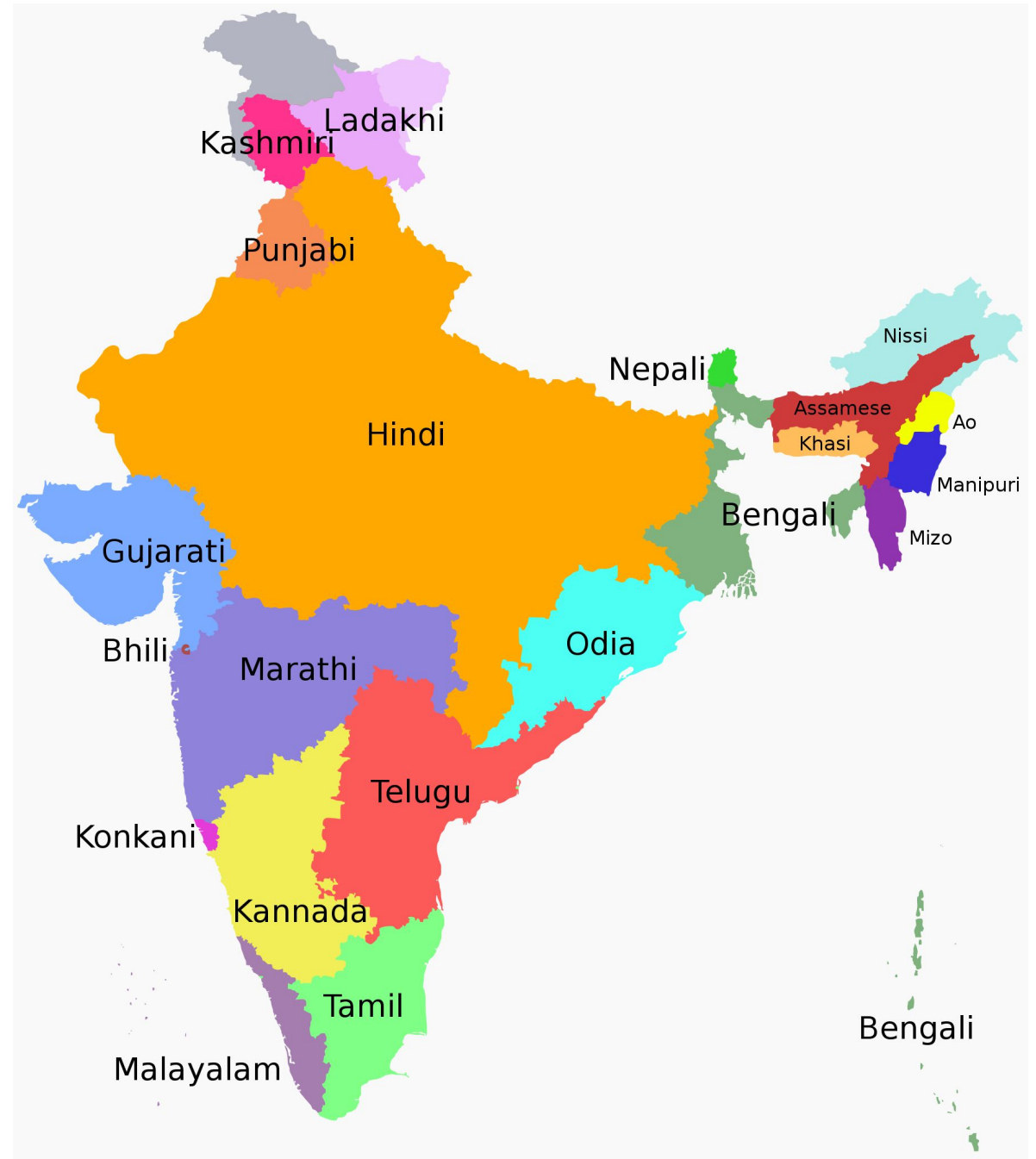


# Where is Hindi spoken?
